## L.E.A.D. PROGRAM PROTOCOL

The L.E.A.D. Organization is designed to assist Law Enforcement Agencies and School Districts in promoting services and interests designed to help all members of communities. Certified L.E.A.D. Instructors should maintain the high standards of their Law Enforcement Agency or School District.

- 1. A L.E.A.D. certified instructor is a highly trained individual who understands the need to adhere to curriculum content standards and ensure that they serve their local agencies, Law Enforcement Organizations, and School Districts to the benefit of everyone.
- 2. A L.E.A.D. instructor must adhere to trademark and copyright laws and understand that L.E.A.D. is a service mark owned by L.E.A.D. and is registered with the Federal Government as a registered trademark.
- 3. All L.E.A.D. merchandise, curricula, and materials administered by L.E.A.D. must be purchased directly from L.E.A.D. or a licensed vendor.
- 4. L.E.A.D. instructors will be supervised and given the opportunity to excel in their position. Any issue regarding a L.E.A.D. instructor will be referred to their local agency, law enforcement organization, or school district and be governed within their own department.
- 5. L.E.A.D. Trainers will assist certified officers and educators on a continuing basis to be the best they can be.
